



What is PTA?

PTA (Parent Teacher Association) is a non-profit, volunteer organization made of parents, teachers and community members committed to enhancing the educational experience for all children.

PTA is part of a local, state and national organization. By joining the local Oak Creek PTA, you are automatically a member of the State and National PTAs.

Your PTA membership allows you the privilege to vote on critical PTA business such as adopting the year's budget and bylaws. It also gives our local PTA a vote on state and national issues.

Who can join PTA?

Anyone can join! PTA is an inclusive organization that is open to all adults who care about children and schools. We actively invite all parents to be involved in their children's education through participation in PTA. We work hard to bring mothers, fathers, teachers, school administrators, grandparents, mentors, foster parents, other caregivers, and community leaders into the association.

Together as a team, we become advocates for our children's health, welfare, education and safety.

Do I have to attend the PTA meetings?
